My interest in peace building was significantly sharpened during a Tour of Duty as Hospital Chaplain at Camp Bastion in Afghanistan. Disturbed by the ugliness of war, which clearly has no winners, I returned home towards the end of 2008 determined to work for a kind of peace that can be experienced by everyone regardless of their creed or culture.

Aware of how the opinions and views of young people can so easily be overlooked progressively led to them being included in my peace building plans.

Conversations ensued with the then WELB who readily opened a door enabling direct contact with schools in the former Derry City Council area. Amazingly, every school became involved by writing a twenty-five word peace pledge.

Greatly encouraged by this response schools, across NI and in the three Border counties, were subsequently invited to participate. Impressively more than 400 peace pledges have, so far, been created by Controlled, Maintained, Integrated, Irish Medium and Special schools. Essentially each pledge is an expression of what young people, growing up in emerging peace, consider we all must do if we are to live better together.

The words and wisdom of so many young people, encapsulated in their peace pledges, confirms they have the capacity to forge a path of good hope that shimmers with peace and prosperity for all.
